Title

Does the thesis contain enough controversy to warrant a 3 page paper?

What type of information is contained in the introduction? Does it all relate to the thesis?  
Is the information relevant? For example, it should contain very little (or nothing) about  
the author.

Are the three main points stated briefly and clearly?

Does the intro contain quotes? If so, are they handled properly?  
(integration/mechanics/citation)

Works Cited page in correct format (alpha order, no URLs, hanging indention, etc)

All works listed on WC page are used in paper; all citations used in paper are in WC

Header on first page (your name, my name, Semester 12, pd \_\_, Date); last name pg on other pages in upper right corner

Look for smoothness and style.
